## Please read these instructions carefully before using the product.

- WARNING: Disconnect from the mains supply before carrying out any routine maintenance.
- WARNING: Misuse of the appliance could cause personal injury.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 years and supervised.
- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children less than 8 years.

#### **MAINS CABLE**

- The heater must not be located directly below a socket outlet.

#### **ELECTRICAL DETAILS**


- Make sure that the power voltage used is consistent with the voltage specified on the rating plate of the device.
- Should the fuse in the mains plug require changing, replace it with one of the same rating as originally fitted.
- The power consumption in off mode into which the equipment is switched automatically is 0.23W. When the appliance is not working, it enters the off mode immediately (0 min).
- WARNING: This appliance must be earthed.













- Remove all packaging and stand the heater on a firm, level surface.
- Ensure that textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material is a minimum distance of 1 metre from the heater.
- Open the battery cover at the bottom of the remote control, as shown below.
- Check the polarity of the battery and install it into the battery cover, as shown below.
- · Refit the battery cover on to the remote control.





**WARNING:** Danger of explosion if batteries are incorrectly installed. Replace the battery only with the same type of battery.

**WARNING:** Keep the remote control and battery out of reach of children.

## **MATTERY WARNING**

- WARNING: Do not cover or place any objects on the heater. Keep textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material a minimum distance of 1 metre from the appliance.
- Before the (touch screen) control panel or remote control can be used to operate the heater, the Power ON/OFF Switch (8) at the rear of the heater should be turned to the ON position.
- The heater will beep twice and enter the standby state.
- The standby ON/OFF button (1) and the timer button (1) will illuminate.
- Press the Standby ON/OFF button (1) to turn on the heater, it can be pressed again to turn back to standby.
- When heating at low power, the low power LED : is illuminated, at high power LED 💥 is on, and the cooling LED is 🛠
- The default set temperature of 35°C and LED °C will be on.
- When the timer is being used the LED h is on.
- The fan is turned on.
- In ECO mode, the LED [[]] is on.

#### Power Level/Cool Function Button

In the standby state, press the heat/cool button 1/2 to toggle between the low power heat → high-power heat → cooling mode.

Note: When switching from low power to high power, there will be a 10 second delay until the high power heat operates.

#### **Cooling Mode**

After entering the cooling mode the LED \* lights up, and the heater automatically keeps the room temperature at 7°C.







#### **Control Panel Lights On/Off**

• Press the screen off \* button to turn the control panel lights off, to turn back on press the screen off button \* again.

#### **Swing Button**

While the heater is operating use the swing button to oscillate the heater left to right, the indicator will illuminate.
 Press the swing button again to turn off oscillation.

#### **Timer Button: Schedule Off Function**

- When the heater is powered on and in use, press the timer button  $\overline{\bigcirc}$  to enter the schedule off function.
- Then press the or + button to set the time (the setting range is 0-24 hrs).
- If no button is pressed within 5 seconds or if you press any button other than  $\bar{\bigcirc}$  and , +. The schedule off function setting is complete and countdown starts.
- After the countdown is over, the heater shuts down and enters the standby state without sound.

#### **Timer Function**

- While the heater is in standby, press the timer button  $\bigcirc$  to enter the timer function, the LED  $\uparrow$  turns on, press the or + button to set the time. (The setting range is 1-24H).
- If no button is pressed within 5 seconds or if you press any button other than and - , +. The timer schedule is complete and countdown starts.
- After the timer period is over, the heater automatically turns on at the last setting.







#### **Temperature/ECO Function**

- Press the Temperature/ECO select button <sup>1</sup>/<sub>100</sub> to cycle through the functions of temperature setting → ECO mode → temperature setting.
- The temperature setting range is 15° 35°.
- The setting completes if there is no operation within 5 seconds or when you press any key other than  $\bigcirc$  and -, +.
- When the ambient temperature reaches the set temperature, all functions turn off (entering the shutdown, sleep state), when the ambient temperature drops to 2°C below the set temperature, the heater turns on again.
- The control panel only displays the temperature by default. The temperature and timer are displayed alternately with an interval of 30 seconds only when the timer is set.

#### **ECO Mode**

- After entering the ECO mode, the LED [[]] lights up, the control panel does not display (if the timer is not turned on).
- The heater automatically adjusts the heating power according to the room temperature to make the equipment more energyefficient.

#### It operates as follows:

- When the ambient temperature is equal to or less than 18°C, the heater runs at high power.
- When the ambient temperature is greater than 18°C and less than 25°C, the heater runs at low power.
- When the ambient temperature is equal to or greater than 25°C, all functions are turned off.

#### Minus and Plus Buttons

 When in the temperature or timer setting modes, the - or + key can be used to increase or decrease the temperature or timer setting. (Press and hold either button for 2 seconds to quick increase/ decrease).

### **OTHER FUNCTIONS**

#### **Automatic Standby Function**

- If the heater has been switched on for 12 hours without the touch control panel or remote control being operated during this period, it will automatically enter the standby state.
- Overturn protection: If the heater overturns, it enters the power-off state. When returned to upright, it enters the standby state.

#### **Display Panel Dimming**

 If the heater has been working continuously for 1 minute without the control panel or remote control being operated, the control panel will dim to eliminate glare at night, brightness will restore when any function is selected on the control panel or remote control.

#### **Power-on Memory Function**

• If the heater is switched off without disconnecting the power, it will retain the working state and it will restart in the mode it was using before being switched off (except for the timer function).








#### **High Temperature Protection Function**

- If the heaters' ambient temperature sensor exceeds 55°C, the heater is forced to shut down and enter the standby state. Only when the temperature drops below 45°C, can it be restarted manually.
- If the heaters' ambient temperature sensor is open or short circuited, the heater is in a protected state and can't be turned on, the control panel displays "EE".

#### Operation of the Fan and Heater

- · While the heater is switched on the fan will operate.
- When the heater is switched off, it will stop working immediately but there will be a delay of 30 seconds before the fan stops.

#### **CARE AND CLEANING**



- To clean the main body and front grille, wipe with a dry cloth. Do not use gasoline, thinner or corrosive detergent or solvent. Do not clean with water or immerse the heater in water.
- If the filter becomes dirty, it will affect the air output, clean at least once every month for optimum operation. Do not use chemicals for cleaning.
- Cleaning the filter and rear cover: remove the filter from behind the rear cover (7) soak the filter and rear cover in warm soapy water, ensure it is dried thoroughly before refitting.



## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution	
No power or not switching on.	Check the fuse and try a new fuse with the same rating.	
	Try a different appliance in the socket as it may be the socket that is at fault.	
Burning smell.	Check the heater is free from dust etc. Turn off the heater and allow to cool thoroughly. Follow the instructions in the Care and Cleaning section to clean the heater and filters.	
	Ensure textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material is a minimum distance of 1 metre from the heater.	
Heat flow is reduced.	Turn off the heater and allow to cool thoroughly. Follow the instructions in the Care and Cleaning section to clean the filters.	
Not turning on.	Check that the On/Off Power switch at the back of the heater is in the On position.	
Remote Control not working.	Change the battery. Type CR2032.	
Tripping Electrics.	Try using a different socket.	
	Ensure there are no other appliances being used on the same set of sockets as the heater.
